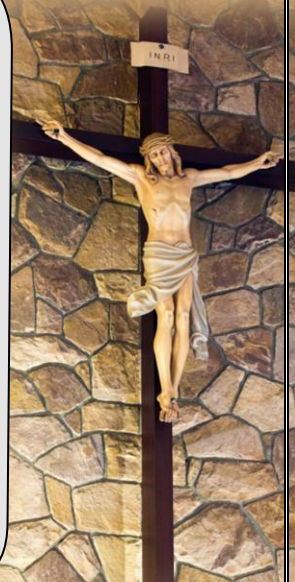

FROM THE PARISH FINANCE COMMITTEE:

At our June Finance Council Meeting we reviewed our St. Anthony's May year-to-date donations and costs. For this period (151 days) our total operating donations works out to be \$1,341/day compared to \$1,295/day in costs to operate the Parish. This Actual surplus is very slim and reflects, in part, a difficult economic time and declining trends previously reported in our general collections that are Under Budget. Costs are being managed carefully under Budget. However, if we continue at this rate there is risk of a shortfall for 2017 and certainly, if our TIA goal is not met of \$50,577. We still have \$30,000 to go and any TIA shortfall must be paid from operations. The good news is that we have not missed our TIA target for the last 14 years! As you are aware the TIA program supports our local Alberta charities, their work, invaluable to our community. So to recap: Please *support the TIA campaign and our commitment that ends December 31* (sooner than later is best!); Please *consider if you can increase your present level of general collection support*, and if you attend St. Anthony's (Latin or English Mass) please register, if you are not registered already. **Thank you for your cooperation and support!**
